Quality Counts

Any FFA member that will be showing at major livestock shows this school year MUST complete the Quality Counts program, if you have not already done so. You must complete the online course and pass the exam at the end to be Quality Counts verified. If you just moved up from elementary to JH or JH to HS you must take the next level test. Directions on how to complete this process are attached to the Google Classroom.

HLSR Show Entries

If you are showing a major show animal (sheep, goats, pigs or broilers) at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, entries and payment need to be turned in no later than October 15, 2019. Don't forget to include your extra badges and parking passes you may want.

Major Show Hotels

If you are showing at any of the major shows, it is your responsibility to make your hotel reservations. Please do not let this get away from you. Make reservations EARLY!
