Registration & Cost

- To build a project for the CFISD Livestock Show you will submit an entry form found on the CFISD Livestock Show Website and make your payment on School Cash.
- Ag Mech Entry Deadline is **December 8th at 2:50pm** - This is a hard deadline!!
- **Entries are \$25**
- Show will be **February 2nd at 4:00pm**
- All material costs are the responsibility of the student or they make seek to have their project sponsored. Mrs. Neuendorf can help you with quotes on materials.

Categories

The below categories are what your student may enter a project in as. There will be a new division this year that involves Ag Engineering.

DIVISION I: AGRICULTURAL MACHINERY & EQUIPMENT

CLASS 1: Hay Hauling, Spraying Equipment, Mounted and Pull Type Tractor Equipment, Self-Propelled Equipment, and Hydraulic Equipment

CLASS 2: Shop Tools and Equipment, Truck, Tractor, and Ag Equipment Accessories

CLASS 3: Livestock and Utility Trailers

DIVISION II: LIVESTOCK EQUIPMENT

CLASS 4: Gates, Livestock Panels, Squeeze Chutes, Livestock Restraining, Livestock Equipment, Trim Chutes, Block Stands, Livestock Crates, Head Gates, Saddle Racks, Tack Boxes, Tack

CLASS 5: Feeders, Self Feeders, Creep Feeders, Storage Buildings

CLASS 6: Wildlife Accessories

DIVISION III: HOME & YARD RECREATIONAL PROJECTS

CLASS 7: Home and/or Furniture

CLASS 8: Yard

DIVISION IV: NON-AG PROJECTS - BBQ PITS

CLASS 9: Free Standing BBQ Pits, Cooking Equipment

CLASS 10: BBQ Pit On Trailers

Eligibility

- Any student who shows for the CFISD Livestock Show is still subject to UIL Eligibility Rules!
- What does this mean? Your student *MUST BE PASSING ALL CLASSES* on their **December 18th Report Card** to be eligible for show. If they fail one or more classes then they *MUST BE PASSING ALL CLASSES* by their **January 22nd Progress Report** in order to regain eligibility.

What happens to the project after show?

- All Ag Mech projects may be sold via silent auction. If your project is already sponsored by someone you will select that it's not for sale on your entry forms.
- It is up to your student to market themselves and network with businesses who may want to attend our auction as a potential buyer (IT'S A TAX WRITE OFF!)

How do I get started?

- We will notify you when the entry forms and school cash items are live for you to access. Please watch your email, our social media and your schoology courses/groups!
- **You will need to first fill out the entry form and pay your fees before the deadline.**
- If you are planning to build your project at Bridgeland High School and use the assistance of Mrs. Neuendorf then you must submit building plans and a materials list **NO LATER than October 31st** and will pay a Shop Fee based on the type of project:
 - Wood Project = \$50
 - Metal Project = \$100

How do I know what to do with my project?

- Construction schedules will be set on a first come, first serve basis and will be after school.
