

Registration Selection & Cost

- To raise a goat for the CFISD Livestock Show you will submit an entry form found on the CFISD Livestock Show Website and make your payment on School Cash.
- Goat Entry Deadline is September 24th at 2:50pm This is a hard deadline!!
- Goats are \$420 this includes the goat and entry fee for show
- Virtual Number Draw will be September 29th
- Animal Selection will be October 10th
- Show will be February 3rd at 6:00pm

Eligibility

- Any student who shows for the CFISD Livestock Show is still subject to UIL Eligibility Rules!
- What does this mean? Your student MUST BE PASSING ALL CLASSES on their <u>December 18th Report Card</u> to be eligible for show. If they fail one or more classes then they MUST BE PASSING ALL CLASSES by their January 22nd Progress Report in order to regain eligibility.
- If your student is ineligible to show your animal must be removed from the school barn by the end of the show week.
- It is your responsibility to remove the animal from the barn or it can be relinquished back to the Bridgeland FFA Chapter.

What happens to the animals after show?

- The top 10 or top 25% from each species will be eligible for our Premium Live Auction. Due to COVID-19 we aren't quite sure what this will look like yet, but CFISD has assured us they are committed to our Livestock Show and Sale, even if it looks differently than the past.
- It is up to your student to market themselves and network with businesses who may want to attend our auction as a potential buyer (IT'S A TAX WRITE OFF!)
- Any student who does not make the Premium Live Auction will redirect their project to the Barn Sale. It is up to your student, and more important than ever this year, to find their own buyer for their animal in barn sale!
- These are Market Animals and will be harvested for meat at the conclusion of the 2021 Livestock Show. Additional fees must be paid to keep your animal.

How do I get started?

- We will notify you when the entry forms and school cash items are live for you to access. Please watch your email, our social media and your schoology courses/groups!
- You will need to first fill out the entry form and pay your fees before the deadline.
- Barn rent is \$150 which includes a \$75 refundable deposit.
- We house our animals at the Westgreen Barn (right across the street from Cypress Park High School and the new Junior High)
- **Barn use applications** can be found on the CFISD Livestock Show Website and will also be paid through School Cash.

What do I feed my goat?

Goats are ruminant animals, which means they need hay daily to prevent bloat, along with free-choice water.

Good feeds to choose from are:

- Producer's
- Purina Honor Show Chow
- Excel

Supplements your advisor may suggest to use are:

- Champion Drive
- Fitter 35
- Show Rite Muscle in Motion

How do I know what to do with my goat?

- Barn Workout Days will be on Thursday or every week. At this time your advisor will go over weights, feeding amounts, care and basic showmanship.
- We don't yet know what schedules at the barns will look like, so specific times will be communicated later.
